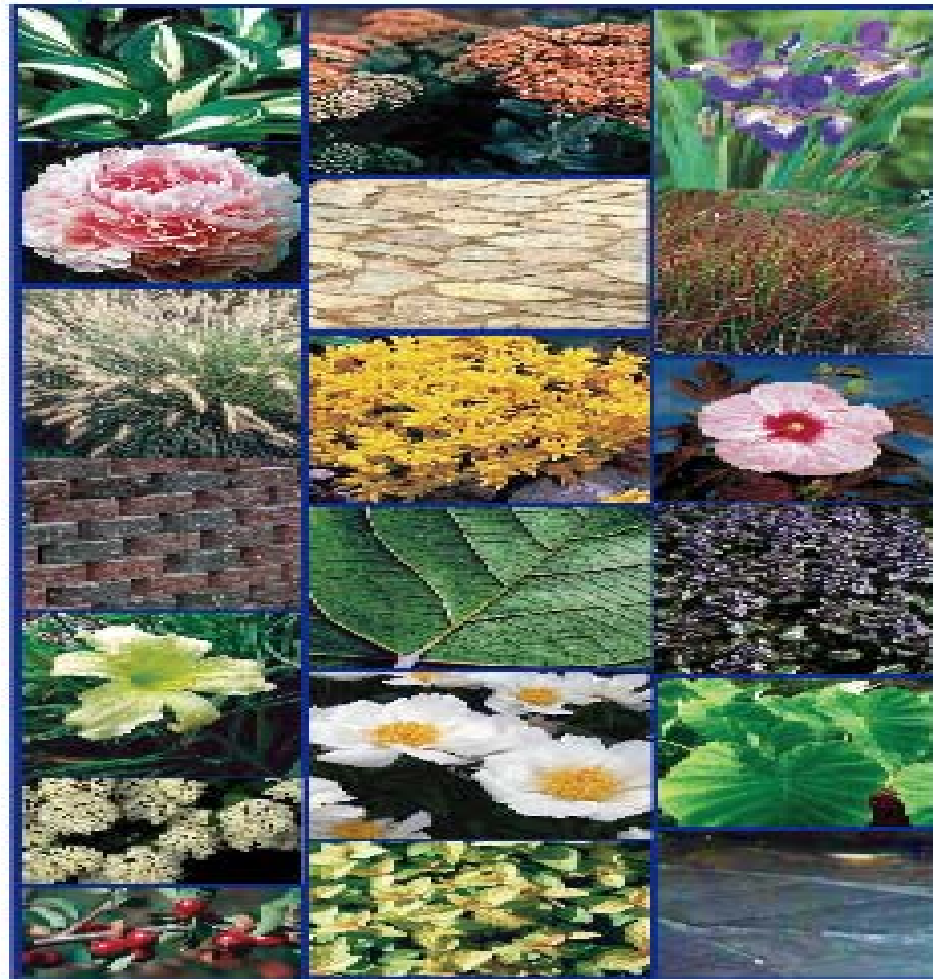

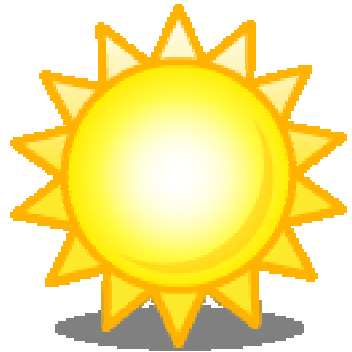

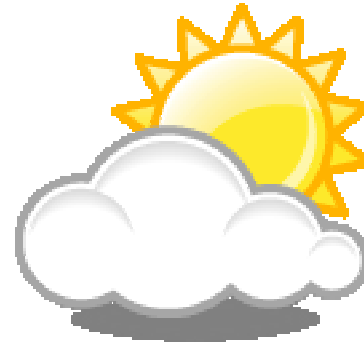

Alchemilla - Lady's Mantle



The Alchemilla 'Lady's Mantle', *Alchemilla mollis*, is a brilliant foamy clusters of tiny, star like flowers with velvety soft olive-green leaves. The foliage catches and holds water drops while sparkling in the sun. This is a fast growing, low maintenance perennial as a ground cover or mass plantings, this is the one for you.

Unique deep purple foliage, fades to bronzy green in hot summers and its dark red stems and blooms small pinkish and white flowers in spring that last into the summer. Especially good as a border, near variegated plants, woodland edges, rock gardens, perennial borders, or in mass to form an attractive ground cover.

Astilbe –Visions



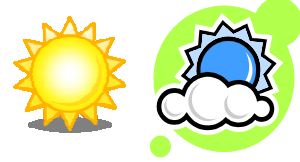
Visions Astilbe is an herbaceous perennial with an upright spreading habit of growth. They are most effective when planted in groupings.



The flowers are excellent for cutting and require little maintenance. It is best cleaned up in early spring before it resumes active growth for the season and is a good choice for attracting butterflies to your yard. It is also considered to be a fairly deer-resistant plant.

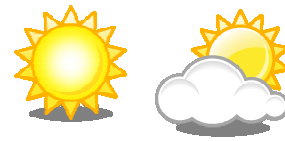
Daylily - Erin Prairie



Extremely adaptable perennials are easy to grow, quick to multiply and virtually pest free. Deadhead spent flowers daily for neatness and remove scapes when flowers have completed bloom. Divide to avoid overcrowding. Tolerant of summer heat and humidity. 6.5" diameter bloom is greenish gold, borne on naked stems above a clump of arching, linear, fountain-like leaves. Provides elegant foliage, color and texture for the garden when the flowers are not in bloom.

Daylily - Happy Returns

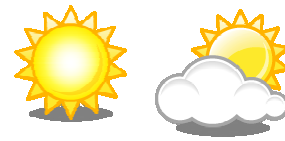


'Happy Returns', also known as a Daylily, is very fragrant. Although the blooms will last only for one day, there are many blooms on strong stems that rise above tall grassy foliage, (remove in late fall).



'Happy Returns' is considered to be pest and deer resistant. Use for cut flowers, massing, edging, in borders or in mixed containers and tubs.

Daylily: Stella de Oro



Stella de Oro will bloom most profusely in full sun, but is tolerant of shade. It will adapt well to a variety of soil conditions and is considered a deer-resistant perennial.

Stella de Oro works well as a border planting, but also makes an attractive mass-planting because of its clumping nature. This daylily plant also makes a great container plant and works well as a cut flower as well. Although individual blooms only last 1 day, they will re-bloom when spent blooms are dead-headed and brown stems are removed.

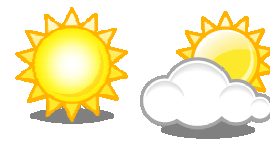
Dianthus - Baths Pink

These fragrant, spicy dove like flowers look wonderful as a border plant, rock gardens, along walks or paths, for edging and a definite in cottage gardens.

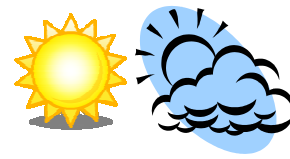
Dianthus - Cheddar Pink

Smaller types make excellent ground covers, and are good in containers. All make exceptional cut flowers. In hot summer areas, plant in partial afternoon shade. Cut back or shear after bloom for repeat bloom.

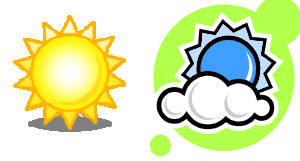
Fern - Cinnamon



Cinnamon Ferns are a wonderful backdrop in larger gardens with Hostas and other large perennials. Although they have a fast growth rate, they spread slowly making beautiful stands of graceful fronds. Crowns should be transplanted in the spring and early summer, planting them right at the level of the soil.

Geranium - Rozanne



Selected as the 2008 Perennial Plant of the Year. Excellent for long-season display. It forms a mid-sized mound of deeply-cut green leaves, bearing loose clusters of bright violet-purple cup-shaped flowers starting in early summer. Performs well towards the front of a border, also excellent for massing or in mixed containers. Prune back by half to rejuvenate, if flowering lags during hot weather:

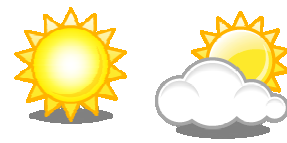
Hibiscus – Kopper King

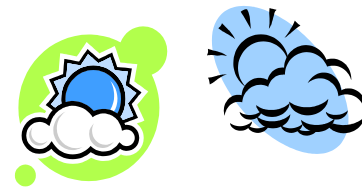
Hosta - Francee

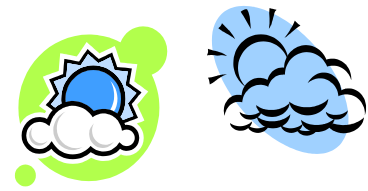

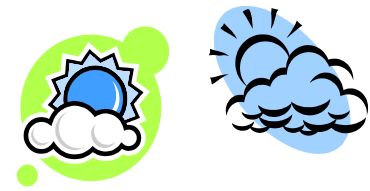
Hosta – Fire and Ice

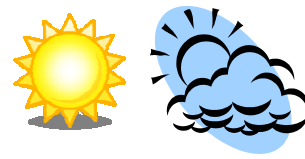


Catmint Walkers Low - *Nepeta Faassenii*

It should be planted in full sun, but can tolerate afternoon shade. It is very drought tolerant but does need a well-drained area. Makes an excellent border plant, great in rock gardens, good for naturalizing and in an attractive addition to ornamental herb garden. Attracts butterflies, hummingbirds and bees and is a perfect first gardeners perennial.

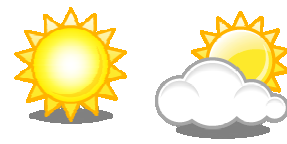
Annabelle Hydrangea

It is best treated like a perennial and pruned to a few inches from the ground in spring.
